Mr. Jevon Gibb, Director, Economic Development Division, reviewed a briefing memorandum describing the proposed Redevelopment Agency (RDA) budget for next year. The big activity will be Magna Main Street. Some of the real estate transactions he was hoping to close in 2022 are being pushed back to early 2023. Then, the RDA is going to continue the façade improvement grant and is looking at doing murals and other beautification projects there to try to activate the neighborhood. Most of the activities on Magna Main Street are due to the reimbursement agreement from the Magna Arbor Park project, which was discussed a couple weeks ago. The project area will just be administered until it closes out in 2030.
