Project: BST – Sandy City

Location: 11565 Big Willow Court

Size: 3.25 acres

Amount Requested: Total project cost is \$669,000. \$334,500 from Salt

Lake County; \$334,500 from Sandy City.

Description: This property is located in the north of Hidden Valley Park, just outside of the Sandy City boundary and approximately 3 miles south of Little Cottonwood Canyon. Located up a private drive east of Wasatch Blvd. The property is 100 feet from an existing trail network and is on the BST masterplan. Only about .25 to .50 acre is need for the trail; however the landowner will not sell a portion of the property.

Recommendation from the Open Space Committee:

- 1. The County contributes 50% of the purchase price, **not to exceed** \$275,000.
- 2. Salt Lake County to hold a conservation easement on the parcel which will be owned by Sandy City.
- If Sandy can sell a portion of the property at a later date that is not needed for trail access, Sandy City reimburse SLCO Open Space equal to the percent of the total purchase price that Salt Lake County contributes.

The Open Space committee voted 7 in favor, no opposed, to this recommendation.
