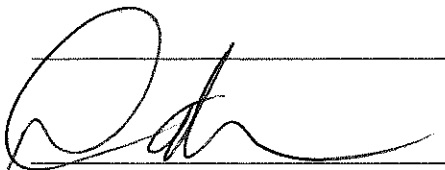
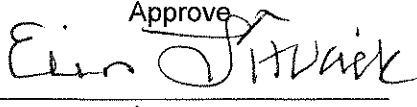

Work-Order TL Positions Reclass Req.: During the 2017 budget process, Information Services division was funded 2 time-limited (TL) PeopleSoft Programmer and Business Analyst positions to manage PeopleSoft-Work Order System integration and ongoing support. A PeopleSoft Programmer is a highly skilled and is in high demand in Salt Lake Valley job market. The Programmer position was posted and open for over 2 months. However, due to the TL status very limited qualified candidates were interested in the job. The Business Analyst position for the Work-Order system requested to engage other county agencies, provide support and manage routine updates and patches to improve service levels, reduce risk and supplement County resources to focus on continual process improvement on an ongoing basis. We are requesting to reclass these 2 positions as Full-time merit position to attract and retain qualified candidates. The alternative to use consulting and contracted services are considered too expensive.

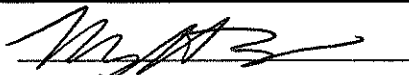

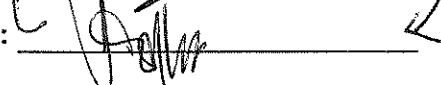

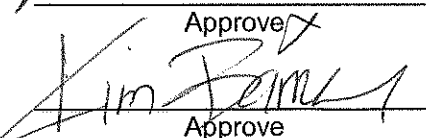

Benefit Summary

The State of Utah Department of Technology Services (DTS) has been asked by the legislature to *"coordinate with the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ), the Governor's Office of Management and Budget (GOMB), and counties to provide resources for local government and the state to plan, scope, design and begin implementing an integrated data system that would coordinate services for vulnerable populations including homeless individuals and families, individuals with mental illness and substance abuse issues, and individuals undergoing rehabilitation through the criminal justice system."*

DTS is developing a Hadoop-based data lake solution to aggregate data for this purpose. To assist in this effort, Salt Lake County is proposing to develop a prototype for data sharing between the state and the counties. This work, in collaboration with the DTS, will result in scalable and repeatable models, service definitions, and processes for data sharing and analysis across jurisdictions.

Project Scope

Salt Lake County will work with the State of Utah to develop data services and automated processes to import county-level data into the state data lake and to export aggregated state-level data from the state data lake. Service definitions and data models will be reusable across the state by other counties.

Proposed Solution

Salt Lake County will develop NIEM-conformant SOAP web services (data APIs) to allow secure authorized download of clean and well-documented county data by the state. These service definitions will use standard data models and be reusable for other counties. Extract, Transform, and Load (ETL) tools will be used for batch transfer to and from the Utah data lake. This data API solution will also allow for more real-time access for information portals, notification systems, and other tools to be developed for service coordination.

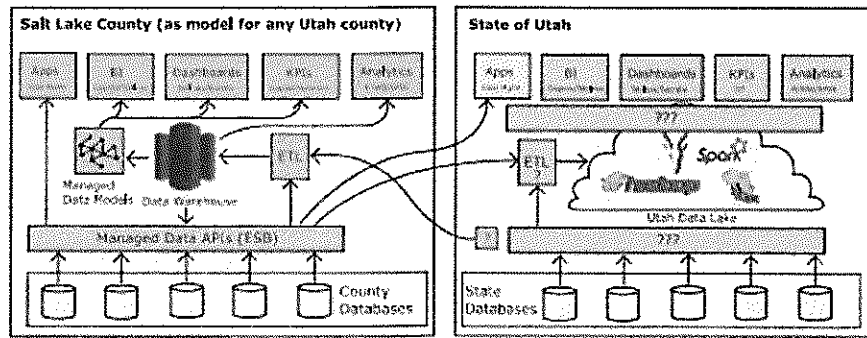
All artifacts of this development, e.g. WSDLs, documentation, and code, will be made available to the state and to other counties to assist in the integration of data from other counties.

To facilitate efficient and robust development of these services and processes, Salt Lake County will procure integrated data management software to include ETL tools and an Enterprise Service Bus (ESB). Additional labor in the form of the temporary assignment of an FTE and/or consulting will be also required as shown in the Estimated Cost table below.

High-level Architecture

The following diagram illustrates the proposed overall architecture including the separation between state and county systems. Though the data management and analytics needs of the state and the counties may be similar in some cases, they are different in scale and encompass different sets of data. In the proposed structure, state data sharing is just a subset of overall data management and analytics at Salt Lake County and vice versa.

The diagram also illustrates some of the questions that need to be addressed in the state's architecture such as how to provide internal and external access to the data lake, how to ingest data, and how to manage quality, access, etc. Salt Lake County envisions that implementation of this pilot project will help to answer these questions.
