RECITALS

- 1. Salt Lake County ("County") owns fee title to two parcels of real property, Parcel No. 33-13-200-003 and Parcel No. 33-13-400-001, located at approximately 15300 South Steep Mountain Drive, Draper, Utah (the "Properties"), by virtue of separate Auditor's Tax Deeds in 1936 for each of the parcels.
 - 2. Each parcel consists of 40 acres of land, near the Point of the Mountain.
- 3. County has been continuously using these parcels as part of the Salt Lake County Flight Park.
- 4. The outstanding tax obligation in the amount of \$9.48 (\$4.89 + \$4.59) has not been paid on the Properties.
- 5. Salt Lake County Division of Parks and Recreation has agreed to pay \$9.48 to clear the outstanding tax obligation and commit the Properties to public use as part of the Salt Lake County Flight Park.
- 6. These proceeds will be distributed in accordance with Section 59-2-1351.5 of the Utah Code and the Properties will be conveyed by Quit Claim deed to the County.
- 7. It has been determined that the best interest of the County and the general public will be served by the conveyance of the Properties to the County for the amount of the outstanding tax obligation. This transaction will be in compliance with all applicable state

statutes and county ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the conveyance of the Properties by Quit-Claim Deed to the County and the payment of the outstanding tax obligation in the amount of Nine Dollars and Fourty-Eight Cents (\$9.48) is hereby approved; and the Mayor and County Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Quit-Claim Deed, ly ıe
