

The Zoo, Arts and Parks (ZAP) Tier II Advisory Board respectfully requests your consideration of their 2017 funding recommendations. During the 2017 funding cycle the ZAP Tier II program received 175 applications, with requests totaling over \$3.26 million dollars. Of the 175 submissions, 20 were new applicants. The ZAP awards are based on a competitive process, organizations that apply are not guaranteed funding.

Four applicants were not recommended for funding because the Tier II Advisory Board determined they did not meet the requirements for funding, did not demonstrate an arts and cultural mission or did not provide a clear public and cultural art benefit. The remaining 171 applicants were recommended for Zoo, Arts and Parks Tier II funding totaling \$1,982,900. There have been no appeals. Attached are the ZAP Tier II Advisory Board 2017 recommendations.

If revenues do not meet projections and are less than the total recommended, each awardee (see detail attached) would be decreased a prorated amount. If the funding is more than the recommended amount, the excess funds will first be used for the Local Arts Agency Advancement initiative and then roll over for the 2018 Tier II process.

On behalf of the Tier II Advisory Board, We respectfully request this recommendation be presented before the Salt Lake County Council for its review and ultimate funding decision on Tuesday, August 29th. 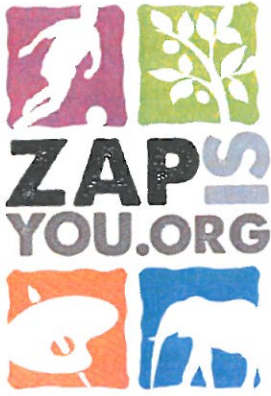

The Zoo, Arts and Parks (ZAP) Tier II Advisory Board respectfully requests your consideration of their 2017 funding recommendations. 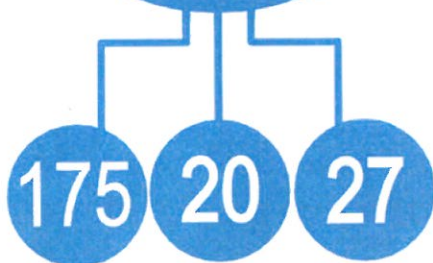
