



Description	<p>Senate Bill 136 (2018) Transportation Governance Amendments provides to Salt Lake County the opportunity to approve a fourth quarter of 1% sales tax to provide transportation funding for roadways, transit, active transportation (bicycles and pedestrian), and trails among other transportation infrastructure.</p> <p>To maximize the amount of funds available to the County, this timeline is proposed to help facilitate projects of regional significance be identified and applied for through an application process from municipalities within Salt Lake County.</p>

Salt Lake County solicits Letter of Intent to Apply for Transportation Project(s) of Regional Significance to municipalities	August 1
Full Application due from Salt Lake County Municipalities	October 1
Contract Specialist (Time Limited) recruiting process starts to help with monitoring and processing of transportation project documentation and reimbursements	October 1
Selection Committee evaluates proposals and makes recommendation to Mayor	November 13
Mayor makes project recommendations to County Council	November 20
County Council acts on recommendations	December 1
Interlocal Agreements are drafted by District Attorney	December 14
Interlocal Agreements before Council for action	December 18
Interlocal Agreements sent to local municipalities for approval	January 5
