#### Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on March 15, 2018, reviewed an application for reinstatement into the tax deferral program. The full market value of the parcel for 2017 was \$181,100.00. Values for 2018 are not yet available. The total delinquency of \$367.63, as of 03/09/2018, includes real property tax delinquencies plus interest. The Committee recommends reinstatement of this deferral under Utah Code Section 59-2-1347 subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Continued monthly payments, reduced to \$100.00, applied to the delinquency;
- 2. All subsequent taxes be paid on or before the due date annually;
- 3. The participant retain their ownership interest in the property during the entire deferral period;
- 4. The property remain occupied during the entire deferral period as the participant's primary residence;
- 5. Yearly submission of an Application for Tax Abatement on or before the filing deadline;
- The deferral be reviewed annually prior to the Tax Sale for compliance with conditions of approval.

Failure to comply with the terms above may result in revocation of the deferral with the total delinquency due immediately.

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on March 15, 2018, considered an application for acceptance into the tax deferral program. The full market value of the parcel for 2017 was \$312,600.00. Values for 2018 are not yet available. The total delinquency of \$11,073.26 as of 03/01/2018 includes real property tax delinquencies plus penalties and interest.

The Committee recommends hardship abatement of \$4,666.00 and that the delinquent balance be deferred under Utah Code Section 59-2-1347 subject to the following conditions:
