RE: Request by Good Shepherd Lutheran Church to grant a real property tax exemption as

a charitable organization for the 2020 tax year on parcel 22-32-352-007 (Recommend

grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on November 18, 2021, considered a request to apply a real property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2020 tax year on the abovementioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In April 2021, Deputy District Attorney Brad Johnson reviewed the application and determined that the property was being used exclusively for charitable purposes. In October 2021, the Board of Equalization granted a tax exemption for the 2021 tax year and referred the prior year to the Property Tax Committee for review.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for the 2020 tax year. A refund in the amount of \$1,639.72 is applicable along with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued. The Treasurer's office shall determine the final amount to be refunded.
