UWS Park Strip Requirements



Trees Encouraged


- Trees are not required, we defer to applicable ordinances
- Trees must be properly irrigated





Drip Irrigation

- Park strips must use inline or point source drip irrigation.
- Microspray emitters do not qualify.





Plant


Coverage


- Minimum 50% plant coverage at maturity
- Plants not to exceed 24" in height






- 3-4" of mulch
- Mulch may be organic or inorganic
- Some cities have requirements as to mulch type






Pedestrian Pass-Throughs

- Hardscaped pass throughs recommended every 30 feet
- Pass-throughs are permeable, not concrete


