19.04.462 Restaurant liquor license.

"Restaurant liquor license" means a public restaurant authorized by the state alcoholic beverage control commission as a liquor outlet allowing the storage, sale and consumption of liquor and alcohol on the premises. <u>Weddings, receptions, and similar</u> <u>events are included in such use.</u>
