RE: 2022 ZAP Tier II Volunteer Advisory Board Nominees

Dear Honorable Mayor Wilson,

Please accept this request of the following nominees to the Salt Lake County (SLCo) Zoo, Arts & Parks program (ZAP) Tier II volunteer Advisory Board. The nominees of the ZAP Advisory Board reflect the recruitment priorities of the Mayor's Office to increase the diversity of backgrounds and perspectives of the board, abides by the operational guidelines of the Tier II volunteer Advisory Board and to the extent practical, is evenly divided by county council. If approved, these appointments would fill all current vacancies for our eleven-member board.

The following nominations are for your consideration:

Mayor Karen Lang – District 3 Ryan Riches – District 5 Brian Van Ausdal – District 6 David Pack – District 5 Kelleigh E Helm – District 2 Bryn Ramjoue – District 1

Nominee Mayor Karen Lang (District 3) would be replacing Mayor Ron Bigelow, both of West Valley City. Mayor Lang was nominated by the SLCo Council of Governments at their meeting held on January 20, 2022. Per County Ordinance 1545 (3.07.060), two mayors from municipalities within Salt Lake County shall serve on the Tier II Advisory Board. Her first term for the ZAP Advisory Board would begin June 7, 2022, and end December 31, 2024.

Nominees Ryan Riches (District 5) **and Brian Van Ausdal** (District 6) were nominated to the ZAP Advisory Board by the SLCo Arts & Culture division volunteer Advisory Board as their designated representatives. SLCo Ordinance 1545 (Chapter 3.07.060), states, that if possible, the Tier II volunteer Advisory Board should have two members from the SLCo Arts & Culture volunteer Advisory Board. Their first term for the ZAP Advisory Board would begin June 7, 2022, and end December 31, 2024.

Nominee David Pack Ph.D. (District 5) is extensively involved in the community as a Councilmember of West Jordan City and chairman or member of municipal commissions, academic associations and local arts organizations' boards as well as being an artist himself. His first term for the ZAP Advisory Board would begin June 7, 2022, and end December 31, 2024.

Nominee Kelleigh E. Helm J.D. (District 2) is the major gifts officer at the University of Utah's UtahPresents. Ms. Helm was nominated by the SLCo Arts & Culture division director. An artist herself and a transplant to Utah, Ms. Helm is interested in being a part of giving Salt Lake County a boost as a place to live. Her first term for the ZAP Advisory Board would begin June 7, 2022, and end December 31, 2024.

Nominee Bryn F. Ramjoue (District 1) is the director of marketing for Utah's Educational Savings Plan, my529. Ms. Ramjoue was nominated by the ZAP program director. Ms. Ramjoue's previous volunteer background is in marketing training for the Utah nonprofit arts and culture sector. Her first term for the ZAP Advisory Board would begin June 7, 2022, and end December 31, 2024.
