- 5. The named jurisdiction is subject to monitoring visits of all grant related activities. This shall include, but not limited to, the right to make site inspections at any time, to bring experts and consultants on site to examine or evaluate completed work or work in progress and to observe all of the named jurisdiction personnel in every phase of performance of grant related work.
- 6. The named jurisdiction must comply with all subaward-specific terms and conditions, including environmental conditions (see FEMA's Agreement Articles) placed on the project. Any change to the approved project scope of work will require re-evaluation for compliance with these requirements. If ground disturbing activities occur during project implementation, the named jurisdiction must ensure monitoring of ground disturbance, and if any potential archeological resources are discovered, they will immediately cease construction in that area and notify FEMA and the appropriate State Historic Preservation Office.
