WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018, Salt Lake County approved an Interlocal Agreement between it and Salt Lake City to provide for the County District Attorney's Office to administer and manage the City prosecutor office;
WHEREAS, the adopted Interlocal did not contain a reporting component requested by the Salt Lake City Council;
WHEREAS, a crrected Interlocal now addresses those concerns requested by the Salt Lake City Council, namely requiring the District Attorney to provide an annual report to the Salt Lake City Council; as well as other technical changes; and
WHEREAS, such an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement has been prepared, is attached hereto, and is agreeable to the parties;
