A RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL APPROVING
CORRECTIONS TO THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN SALT LAKE COUNTY AND SALT LAKE CITY PROVIDING
THAT THE SALT LAKE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY WILL
ADMINISTER AND MANAGE THE CITY PROSECUTOR OFFICE

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Utah Legislature has provided, at Utah Code Section 11-13-202.5 (2016), for the adoption of Interlocal Cooperation Agreements, pursuant to resolutions of the governing bodies of any political subdivisions which are parties to such an agreement; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018, Salt Lake County approved an Interlocal Agreement between it and Salt Lake City to provide for the County District Attorney's Office to administer and manage the City prosecutor office;

WHEREAS, the adopted Interlocal did not contain a reporting component requested by the Salt Lake City Council;

WHEREAS, a corrected Interlocal now addresses those concerns requested by the Salt Lake City Council, namely requiring the District Attorney to provide an annual report to the Salt Lake City Council; as well as other technical changes; and

WHEREAS, such an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement has been prepared, is attached hereto, and is agreeable to the parties;

RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the attached Interlocal Cooperation Agreement is approved; and the Mayor is authorized to execute said agreement, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and by this reference made a part of this Resolution.
