I, Kate Ithurralde hold a personal interest that creates a potential or actual conflict with my public duties.

The brief sum up of this interest is that I want to create a temporary public art piece. This piece will be a 3,125 foot pearl necklace. This necklace will be created out of 6,249 six-inch "pearls" and will be temporarily displayed on Lone Rock in Skull Valley. The land it is located on BLM land. I would like to have an exhibition at a local art gallery or museum, this exhibition will feature the process and documentation of placing the pearl necklace around Lone Rock in Skull Valley.

This project will cost over \$50,000 and I will need to raise the funds for it. For this to be a successful fundraising campaign, I will need to have a multipronged approach to fundraising. Some of these disciplines will include:

- A social media campaign on a third-party site like, Go-Fund Me
- Appling for city, state and federal grants
  - Most grants require the applicant to be a 501C3, I will need to team up with a local art organization like Utah Museum of Contemporary Arts or Art Access and ask them to be my non-profit umbrella so that I can apply for these grants. It is my hope that the exhibition will also be at this non-profit.
- Applying for private funding from local Foundations, including but not limited to the Stewart Family Foundation and the Snow, Christensen & Martineau Foundation.
- In-kind donations:
  - Teaming up with Spy-hop to assist in documenting the process
  - o Teaming up with the Tooele County and Tooele City Arts Festival for cross-promotion
  - Teaming up with Slug Magazine for marketing help
