I then went on to the University of Utah and graduated in 1975 with a major in history and a minor in sociology. In 1975 I was hired by the Granite School District to teach Social Studies at Wasatch Junior High School. While teaching at Wasatch, I went back to the University of Utah to get my administrative credentials.
