The boilers serve in redundancy to each other except during the coldest times of the year. The original burner is a low emissions (nox) unit and was manufactured by John Zink Company, LLC. Since then, the John Zink Co. was purchased and the burner was discontinued; making replacement parts unavailable and repair impossible. Replacement with a similar low emissions burner from a different manufacturer is required. This was orginally budgeted at \$25,000 and was insufficient based on bids received. An additional \$5,000 is being requested to cover the additional funds needed based on bids received.
