A RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL REQUESTING
RECERTIFICATION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY JUSTICE COURT.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, Section 78A-7-103, UTAH CODE ANN., requires Justice Courts be recertified at the end of each four-year term; and

WHEREAS, the current term of the Salt Lake County Justice Court shall expire in February 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Salt Lake County Council has received an opinion letter from the Office of the District Attorney, which sets forth the requirements for the operation of a Justice Court and feasibility of continuing to maintain the same.

R E S O L U T I O N

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Council of Salt Lake County that it hereby requests recertification of the Salt Lake County Justice Court by the Justice Court Standards Committee and the Utah Judicial Council.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Salt Lake County that it hereby affirms its willingness to continue to meet all requirements set forth by the Judicial Council for continued operation of the Salt Lake County Justice Court for the next four-year term of court, except as to any requirements waived by the Utah Judicial Council.
