# PROCLAMATION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL RECOGNIZING THE LIFE OF MAJOR BRENT TAYLOR

WHEREAS, in recognition of a lifelong endeavor of loving service to his family, community and nation, on behalf of the citizens of Salt Lake County, we honor Major Brent Taylor, Mayor of North Ogden City and a major in the National Guard; and;

WHEREAS, when Major Taylor received his orders to deploy to Afghanistan it was an easy choice for him, rooted in decisions he'd made years ago to serve God, his family and his country. "While I am far from perfect in any of these respects," he said, "I have given my life to serve all three of these loyalties whenever and however I can"; and;

WHEREAS, Major Taylor said, "Serving as the mayor of North Ogden City has been one of the greatest honors of my life and the highlight of my civilian professional career. Service is really what leadership is all about", and;

WHEREAS, Major Taylor had a history of military service having been a platoon leader, battalion plans officer, vulnerability assistance officer, explosive ordinance disposal officer, mobile training team chief, selective service officer, and recruitment sustainment program coordinator; and;

WHEREAS, Major Taylor's current deployment was his fourth, after previous tours in Iraq and Afghanistan beginning in December 2006. His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star and Purple Heart, as well as various service and achievement medals; and

WHEREAS, Major Taylor's last Facebook post from Afghanistan stated:

The strong turnout, despite the attacks and challenges, was a success for the long-suffering people of Afghanistan and for the cause of human freedom. I am proud of the brave Afghan and U.S. soldiers I serve with. Many American, NATO allies, and Afghan troops have died to make moments like this possible; for example, my dear friend Lt. Kefayatullah who was killed fighting the Taliban the day before voting began.

"As the USA gets ready to vote in our own election next week, I hope everyone back home exercises their precious right to vote. And that whether Republicans or Democrats win, that we all remember that we have far more as Americans that unites us than divides us. 'United we stand, divided we fall.' God Bless America."

WHEREAS, the annexation is pursuant to Section 10-2-418, UTAH CODE ANN. (2018); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-2-418(4), UTAH CODE ANN. (2018), the County "shall agree to an annexation if the majority of private property owners within the area to be annexed give written consent to the annexation" in compliance with other provisions of Section 10-2-418(4), UTAH CODE ANN. WHEREAS, Sandy City has provided written assurance that it has the written consent of the majority of private property owners within the area proposed for annexation and has also provided proof of written consent of the majority of property owners within the area proposed for annexation; and WHEREAS, the County Council has reviewed the written consent of property owners provided by Sandy City and concluded that the consent complies with the requirements of Section 10-2-418(4), UTAH CODE ANN. (2018), and, therefore, the County is required by Section 10-2-418(4), UTAH CODE ANN. (2018), to agree to the annexation;
