- Water Chemistry – total phosphorous and nitrogen, pH, maximum temperature, specific conductance
- Vegetation – canopy density, riparian cover type and amount for ground cover, understory and canopy
- Overall assessment – watershed activities and impacts, channel constraint, evidence of torrents
