Honorable County Council Members:

Attached, please find a list of proposed 2019 precinct changes to be placed on the December 11, 2018 agenda for Council approval. Also included in your packet are maps of the proposed precinct changes. Twenty-six precincts needed to be adjusted for population growth to comply with the statutory limit of 1,250 voter per precinct. This population growth also resulted in the need to add eight new precincts. Additionally, another eight precincts needed boundary adjustments due to annexations and two precincts needed boundaries changed because of the Bluffdale/Riverton boundary adjustment. Four precinct boundaries will be adjusted to equalize the precinct boundaries, which resulted in the elimination of one precinct.
