2019 Zoo, Arts and Parks Tier I Advisory Board Funding Recommendations

All organizations that applied through this process are ZAP recipients and will continue to be ZAP recipients. The Tier I Advisory Board of the Zoo, Arts and Parks Program takes its review responsibilities seriously and works diligently to achieve a fair and thoughtful process. The board also takes a strong fiduciary role when providing these recommendations to the Salt Lake County Council. State Statute allows not more than 22 organizations in the Tier I category and not more than three organizations in the zoological category. This year 23 applications were received for 22 allowable Tier I slots and three applications for those three allowable Zoological funding recipients. No appeals have been made to these recommendations.

The board noted that the ZAP Tier I process continues to be very competitive and no one organization is guaranteed Tier I status. Any organization could be at risk of not being funded as a Tier I organization in the future.
