RE: Request by Utah Pride Center to grant a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2017 tax year on parcel 15-13-231-028 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on December 20, 2018 considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2017 tax year on the above mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In November 2018, the District Attorney granted an exemption as a charitable organization for the 2018 tax year and recommended the approval of the exemption for the 2017 tax year.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for a prorated exemption for the 2017 tax year, from the date of acquisition of September 14, 2017 to December 31, 2017. The exemption amount of \$5,044.38 shall be applied to the parcel. The Treasurer's office shall make an adjustment for the penalty previously paid and refund any overpayment to the Claimant.
