MEDICAID EXPANSION – BRIDGE PLAN

- Effective April 1, 2019
- 30% Match paid by State
- Up to 100% of poverty qualify
- Eligibility re-evaluated monthly
- A bridge to State's preferred expansion plan in early 2020 awaiting various waiver approvals
- Targeted Adult Medicaid (TAM) continues
 - Chronically homeless, In-jail treatment, Drug or Mental Health Court
 - 12 month eligibility
- County-managed PMHP Plan continues



STATE NON-MEDICAID CUTS

- As much as 80% of the previously non-Medicaid funded behavioral health system covered by Medicaid Expansion
- Statewide Legislative cuts \$10.25 million behavioral health, effective July 1, 2019
 - \$3.6 million to Salt Lake County
- One-time funded social detox and other services expanded as part of Operation Rio Grande further impacted cuts – approx. \$2.5 million
- We believe the Medicaid expansion will cover these impacts

ADDITIONAL REDUCTIONS OF SUD PROGRAMS

The following programs that make referrals to our SUD provider network will also be reduced as follows:

- Drug court recovery support services 100% \$(147,099)
- Intensive Supervision Program (ISP) 57% \$(1,131,787)
- Adult Drug Court Treatment 100% \$(420,539)
- Family Dependency Drug Court 52% \$(122,538)
- Juvenile Drug Court 77% \$(73,947)
- Operation RIO Grande Treatment 100% \$(120,000)
- Total cuts to these programs \$(2,015,910)
