AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF SALT LAKE COUNTY, UTAH, AMENDING SECTION 2.97.050 OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, 2001, ENTITLED "DEBT REVIEW COMMITTEE" REDUCING MEMBERSHIP TO SEVEN AND REDUCING THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE TO ONE MEMBER, ALLOWING THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND AUDITOR TO NAME DESIGNEES

The County Legislative Body of Salt Lake County ordains as follows:

SECTION I. The amendments made herein are designated by underlining the new substituted words. Words being deleted are designated by brackets with a line drawn through said words.

SECTION II. Section 2.97.050, of the Salt Lake County Code of Ordinances, 2001 is hereby amended to read as follows:

### 2.97.050 - Membership.

The committee shall be composed of [eight] <u>seven</u> members consisting of the mayor or mayor's designee, the mayor's chief financial officer, [one] <u>two</u> individuals from the council office chosen by the council, [the council budget director, two members of] the county auditor['s] <u>or designee</u> [office designated by the county auditor], the county treasurer or designee, the district attorney or designee. The chair of the committee shall be rotated annually among the members representing the county auditor, district attorney and county treasurer. The county's financial advisor shall serve as a non-voting, ex-officio member of the committee.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication in a newspaper published and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
