Dear Mayor Wilson,

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board met on July 10, 2019 and reviewed the request of the Arts Council of Magna to receive a fee waiver for the Magna Town Days event. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board voted and recommends that the full amount of \$2,750 requested is waived – the applicant can choose to receive the full amount now or have it split over a two year period.

Magna Town Days – Arts Council of Magna, \$2,750. The purpose of the Arts Council of Magna is to “establish, operate or delegate community programs in order to provide for the development of knowledge and the undertaking of the needs of the people and neighborhoods.” This request will waive the fee to reserve fields for the “Music and Movies in the Park” events in Pleasant Green Park, located in Magna throughout the month of July 2019.

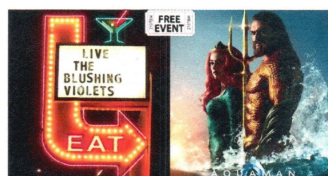

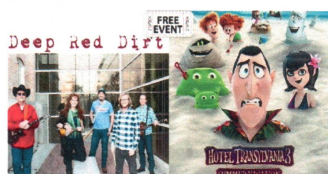


Music & Movie in the Park series opener for 2019

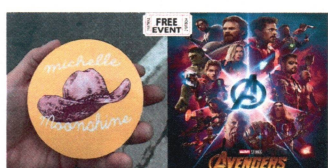

July 19th, 2019 The Backyard Revival & Fantastic Beasts

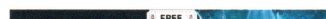
