SECTION I. The amendments made herein are designated by underlining the new substituted words. Words being deleted are designated by brackets with a line drawn through said words.

SECTION II. Section 2.97.010, of the Salt Lake County Code of Ordinances, 2001 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.97.010 - Debt review committee created.

Salt Lake County hereby establishes a[n eight] seven member committee to be known as the Debt Review Committee, which shall review all proposed debt issuance with a repayment schedule that extends beyond the current fiscal year.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication in a newspaper published and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
