Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on September 19, 2019, considered an application for acceptance into the tax deferral program. The property was pulled from the 2019 Final Tax Sale for review under Hardship Deferral under the authority granted to the Committee.

The Committee regretfully recommends denial of a hardship deferral at this time and that the property be certified for the May 2020 tax sale if the outstanding balance is not paid by March 15, 2020. This decision does not preclude an applicant from requesting consideration of a hardship deferral at a later date.

An administrative fee of no less than \$250.00 will be added to any property that is certified for sale. The final 2020 tax sale is tentatively scheduled for May 28, 2020.
