RE: Request by AHT Foundation to grant a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2018 tax year on parcels 21-27-357-021 and 22-32-102-006 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on October 17, 2019, considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2018 tax year on the above mentioned parcels. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In July 2019, the District Attorney's office granted an exemption as a charitable organization beginning with the 2019 tax year. The 2018 request was sent to the Property Tax Committee for consideration. The parcels were exempt prior to the acquisition by AHT. Only the ownership changed, not the use of the properties. AHT acquired the properties from CTA Community Supports which is an exempt entity.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for the 2018 tax year, for a continued charitable exemption on both parcels. No taxes are owing or delinquent.
