The impact of the generous land donation that will become the **Bastian** Agriculture Center will be felt for many generations and will provide an opportunity for people to fully understand where their food comes from.

The center will be based on four components: natural resources; small-farm education as it relates to food; small-farm education as it relates to animal production; and science, technology, engineering and math (STEM). The center will help serve the educational needs of all ages, but especially the growing, younger population The programs and facilities at the future Bastian Agricultural Center will be remarkable, and our goal is to have hands-on, applied learning. Our hope is that this facility will provide education, experiences and a sense of community for those who visit.
