A RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SALT LAKE COUNTY ASSESSOR TO WAIVE PERSONAL PROPERTY FILING PENALTIES AND INTEREST

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL THAT:

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic may make it difficult for businesses to timely file their personal property tax returns and pay the taxes due;

WHEREAS, Salt Lake County Ordinance §3.67.040 provides

Upon submitting an appropriate application within one hundred eighty days after the date of delinquency for property taxes, interest and penalties imposed as a result of the failure of a property owner to make timely payment of property taxes may be waived or reduced upon demonstration of the following factors:...(b) medical circumstances which precluded the taxpayer from making a timely payment and appointing an agent for such matters;

WHEREAS, The Salt Lake County Assessor seeks limited authority to waive personal property tax penalties and interest for failure to file and pay personal property tax imposed by Utah Code Ann. § 59-2-307 and § 59-2-1331

because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Salt Lake County Council resolves as follows:

1. Under the authority granted by Utah Code Ann. §59-2-1347, the Salt Lake County Council hereby adopts this resolution and authorizes the Salt Lake County Assessor to waive penalties and interest due to the late filing and payment of business personal property taxes for returns and taxes first due between January 1, 2020 through August 15, 2020.

2. The waiver applies to all personal property tax returns and taxes first due between January 1, 2020 and August 15, 2020. As applicable by law, penalties will be imposed on untimely returns filed after August 15, 2020, and penalties and interest will begin to accrue after August 15, 2020, on unpaid personal property tax first due between January 1, 2020 and August 15, 2020.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT TO STORM DRAINAGE

AND FLOOD CONTROL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SALT LAKE COUNTY AND SANDY CITY

WHEREAS, the Parties are local governmental units and "public agencies" that are therefore authorized by the Utah Interlocal Cooperation Act, Section 11-13-101, *et seq.*, Utah Code Annotated, to enter into agreements with each other for joint and cooperative action to make the most efficient use of their powers on a basis of mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, in July 1981 Salt Lake County and Sandy City entered into a Storm Drainage and Flood Control Agreement ("Agreement") allowing County to use existing canals within the City for storm drainage and flood control purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, County pays 25 percent of the City's maintenance costs annually; and

WHEREAS, Sandy City operates and maintains the Sandy Irrigation Canal, which traverses Sandy City and currently functions solely to collect stormwater; and

WHEREAS, County and City desire to amend the Agreement to allow County to pay a lump sum of \$50,000 in lieu of continued annual payments and thereafter terminate the Agreement, which is reflected in the attached Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council hereby approves the attached Amendment to Storm Drainage and Flood Control Agreement Between Salt Lake County and Sandy City.
