Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) Mill Creek Canyon Reference Sheet

What is the FLAP?

The FLAP is a funding program provided through the Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) with the purpose of improving access to Federal lands for recreation.

How much money will be awarded?

•The Mill Creek Canyon application will receive \$12 Million.*

•Salt Lake County (along with key partners) is required to provide a local match of 6.77%, or \$812,400. As part of scoping visit, \$10,000 is due 8/1/2020.

•Restroom improvements could be made simultaneously, but are not covered by the FLAP grant. These would cost an approximate \$465,000 in additional funds. (2 restroom relocations, 1 single vault toilet, 6 double vault toilets)

What are the proposed improvements?

•Improve the Mill Creek Canyon Road from 3800 S. Wasatch Boulevard to the Upper Big Water Trailhead (approximately 10 miles).

•Widen the road to 29 feet, which includes a 5' uphill bike lane in the lower canyon, and where possible in the upper canyon.

•Redesign parking to USDA Forest Service standards.


•Enhance crosswalk and pedestrian safety.

•Improve drainage.

•Incorporate future transit facilities into project.
