The Challenge Accepted


- There is a need for steadfast vigilance in maintaining pressure against the virus.

Mortality Rate: 1.252%



MAINTAIN PRESSURE ON THE VIRUS

- Gary Edwards and Clint Mecham to form Unified Command.
- Understand and manage the spread of COVID-19 through disease surveillance, testing, investigation, and contact tracing.
- Develop and strengthen networks and partnerships to gain access to communities and deploy targeted interventions against the virus.
- Support quarantine and isolation operations.
- Prepare for vaccination.

Salt Lake County Adaptive / Long-Term Recovery
COLLABORATIVE REACTIVATION OF OUR COMMUNITIES

- Catherine Kanter and Dina Blaes to spearhead initiatives.
- Mitigate the social and economic impact of COVID-19 in Salt Lake County.
- Monitor current and future impacts of COVID-19 to the social and economic fabric of Salt Lake County.
- Maintain Salt Lake County Government as a conduit of information to community stakeholders on actions and programming regarding mitigation.

The Role of Special Assistant to the Mayor

- Policy advisor for County Mayor on COVID-19 Response and Recovery:
 - Unified Command maintains operational control of COVID-19 Health Response
 - Regional Operations maintains operational control of Adaptive Recovery / Long-Term Recovery
- Maintains connectivity with:
 - COVID-19 Response and Recovery Operations
 - Government Task Force on COVID-19
 - County Council
- Provides support to Salt Lake County Government:
 - Draft special reports and policy-level analysis
 - Develop situation awareness to ensure Salt Lake County is a leader of best practices in a whole community approach

 - Bi-weekly Government Task Force meetings
 - Distribution of summaries/reports
 - Information exchanges
- Support response and recovery operations:
