1.1 Statement of Council Chair Max Burdick Concerning the
Temporary Conduct of Electronic Meetings of the Council
Consistent with the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act

OPMA Findings - August 2020

Mr. Mitchell Park, Legal Counsel, Council Office, referred to the following temporary conduct of electronic meetings that is consistent with the Utah Open and Public Meeting Act, thereby allowing the Council to hold electronic meetings without a physical anchor location, and requested the Clerks enter it into the record:

Consistent with provisions of the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act, Utah Code Ann. § 54-2-207(4), and acting in my capacity as Salt Lake County Council Chair, I hereby make the following written determinations in support of Salt Lake County Council's decision to hold and convene electronic meetings of the Council without a physical anchor location:

- 1. Conducting Council meetings with an anchor location that is physically accessible for members of the public to attend in person presents a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location; and
- 2. This determination is based upon the following facts, among others:
 - a. Salt Lake County remains under a state of public health emergency related to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, and significant, continued person-to-person transmission of the SARS-CoV-2 virus continues to

occur in Salt Lake County;

- b. State and local health authorities have adopted "Phased Guidelines for the General Public and Business to Maximize Public Health and Economic Reactivation, Version 4.6," which orders institutions and persons in moderate risk or "orange" jurisdictions, including Salt Lake City, to take "extreme precautions," including allowing "in-person interactions in decreased group sizes that enable all physical distancing guidelines to be maintained; social interactions in groups of 20 or fewer" and recommending "increase[d] virtual interactions";
- c. Mayor Jennifer Wilson has ordered that the Salt Lake County Government Center be open to the public on an "appointment only" basis during the current period of Salt Lake County Government's phased re-opening;
- d. The health and safety of Councilmembers, County officials and employees, staff, and members of the public is best served by holding electronic meetings of the Council with limited in-person interaction of fewer than 20 persons;
- e. The Council has prepared for and demonstrated the ability to effectively conduct its public meetings electronically, including providing members of the public means to observe the Council's meetings and provide comments electronically.

These written determinations shall be read into the minutes at the beginning of the Salt Lake County Council's Committee of the Whole and Council Meetings, held in Salt Lake City on August 25, 2020, and at future Council meetings as appropriate. Council staff are instructed to continue including in the public notice information on how a member of the public may view and make comments at the Council's electronic meetings.

This written determination is effective until midnight on September 23, 2020, and may be re-issued by future written determinations of the Chair at that time.

THE A RESOLUTION OF **SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL APPROVING** THE **RELEASE** OF AN **EASEMENT PREVIOUSLY GRANTED** TO **SALT LAKE** COUNTY **AND** APPROVING THE **ACQUISITION** OF A **NEW EASEMENT FROM CARRINGTON** SQUARE, L.L.C

RECITALS

- A. Salt Lake County ("County") possesses an easement across real property owned by Carrington Square, L.L.C. ("Grantor") in Salt Lake County. The easement was granted in 1984 to maintain a portion of Salt Lake County's storm water system (the "Original Easement").
- B. Salt Lake County Flood Control has determined that it no longer needs a portion of the Original Easement because Grantor has offered to construct a portion of the storm water facilities in a new location.
- C. Grantor has requested that the County release the portion of the

easement that is no longer needed so that they can utilize the underlying property.

- D. The County is willing to release the portion of the Original Easement on Grantor's property that is no longer needed in exchange for the Grantor granting to the County a small easement on an adjacent portion of Grantor's property (the "New Easement"). Grantor has also agreed to construct storm drain facilities on the New Easement and pay the County \$150.00, the minimum fee charged for real estate transactions, for the release of the Original Easement.
- E. It has been determined that the best interests of the County and the general public will be served by releasing and relinquishing the portion of the Original Easement no longer needed by the County in exchange for the New Easement from Grantor. The exchange of the easements will be compliance with all applicable state statutes and county ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the Agreement for Release and Grant of Easements is hereby approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for Release and Grant of Easements, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and by this reference made a part hereof, and deliver the fully executed document to the County Real Estate Section.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that upon receipt of the fully executed New Easement, attached to Exhibit 1, as Exhibit A from Grantor, completion of the storm drain facilities to the satisfaction of Salt Lake County Flood Control, and the \$150.00 payment as provided in the Agreement for Release and Grant of Easements, the Mayor and County Clerk are authorized to execute the Release of Easement, attached to Exhibit 1, as Exhibit B, and by this reference made a part of this Resolution, and to deliver the fully executed document to the County Real Estate Section for delivery to Grantor.

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING SURPLUS REAL PROPERTY AND APPROVING THE CONVEYANCE OF THE SAME BY QUIT-CLAIM DEED TO WEST END LLC

RECITALS

- 1. Salt Lake County ("County") owns a parcel of real property, Parcel No. 15-11-278-017, located at approximately 717 West Genesee Avenue, Salt Lake City, Utah (the "Property"), which was struck off to the County after the tax sale in 2007.
- 2. West End LLC ("West End"), has offered in writing to purchase the Property from the County for \$1,700.00, which amount has been approved by the County Real Estate Section as fair market value. This offer is in the form of a Tax Sale Property Purchase Agreement (the "Agreement") attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 3. The County has determined that the Property is not in public use. Proceeds from the sale of the Property will be distributed in accordance with Section 59-2-1351.5 of the Utah Code.
- 4. It has been determined that the best interest of the County and the general public will be served by the sale and conveyance of the Property to West End. The sale and conveyance will be in compliance with all applicable state statutes and county ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the Property, described in Exhibit 1 of the Agreement is hereby declared surplus property.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the sale and conveyance of the Property by quit-claim deed to West End as provided in the Agreement for the agreed appraised value of One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,700.00) is hereby approved; and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and the Mayor and County Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Quit-Claim Deed, attached to the Agreement as Exhibit 2, and to deliver the fully executed documents to the County Real Estate Section for delivery to West End upon payment of the agreed upon purchase amount.
