Dear Honorable County Council Chair Burdick,

The Zoo, Arts and Parks (ZAP) Tier II Advisory Board respectfully requests your consideration of their 2020 funding recommendations. During the 2020 application cycle, the ZAP Tier II program received 198 eligible applications, with requests totaling over \$3.3 million dollars. Of these submissions, the Advisory Board is recommending **198** applicants for Tier II funding totaling **\$2,347,400**.

The ZAP awards are based on a competitive process and organizations that apply are not guaranteed funding. After vigorous review, all 198 eligible applications have been recommended for funding based on application quality and community impact.

If revenues do not meet projections and are less than the total recommended, each awardee (see detail attached) would be decreased a prorate amount. If the funding is more than the recommended amount, the excess funds will first be used for the Local Arts Agency Advancement initiative and then roll over for the 2021 Tier II process.

Thank you for your consideration of this request and for your continued support of the Zoo, Arts and Parks program.
