### Presentation Highlights


- Items included in Mayor's budget (\$2.7M)






Significant decrease in vacancies.

2020 year-to-date turnover Sheriff's Office sworn compared to County





The increase in environmental pay will help our continued efforts to staff the critical civilian roles in our Office.


#### **Vacancies**

In the future we will be looking to gain Council support for:

- PSB Span of Control (\$508k)
- Academy FTEs (\$999k)
