Dear Mayor Wilson,

I am writing in request of your support to extend three Arts & Culture Advisory Board terms. The current Board Members Bing Fang, Daphne Williams and Gordon Williams are each finishing their 1st term in the current 2020 year.

Arts & Culture would like to request an extension for one additional full term, extending their status through 2023. Our by-laws state that we may have 11-15 members.
