We aim to combat human trafficking through trauma-informed education, training, and reporting protocols for schools.

PROTECT was created in 2015 by three anti-trafficking non-profits: 3Strands Global Foundation, Frederick Douglass Family Initiatives, and Love Never Fails. To date, the program has reached over 500,000 people (est.).

#### DEFINITION OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

According to the U.S. Department of State

"Modern slavery" and "human trafficking" are umbrella terms for the act of **recruiting**, **harboring**, **transporting**, **providing**, or **obtaining** a person for <u>compelled labor</u> or <u>commercial sex</u> acts through the use of **force**, **fraud**, or **coercion**.

#### What is Force, Fraud & Coercion?

FORCE: The use of physical harm or violence

FRAUD: Deception for financial gain

**COERCION:** Persuading someone to do something by using force or threats




## SIGNS OF ONLINE GROOMING

Emotion	Core Message from Vulnerable Youth	What it looks like online	Trafficker's Strategic Response	Trafficking Repellent
Disappointment	My life is not going suwell/not fulfilled.	"My life sucks."	I'll make your life better	My life is alright.
Connection	I don't have friends/family who care/connect to.	"She's not my true friend"	I'll be your best friend.	I have friends and family that care about me.
Emptiness/Love	I'm not feeling loved.	"I am so sick of being single"	I love you.	I am loved.



Research shows that Family Members are involved in **nearly half** of child trafficking cases








These cases are only a sample of the Human trafficking cases going on in our state.

What needs do we have that make us vulnerable to exploitation?






### IDENTIFIED "RISK FACTORS" FOR CHILD TRAFFICKING

- Lack of personal safety
- Isolation
- Emotional distress
- Homelessness
- Poverty
- Family dysfunction
- Substance abuse
- Mental illness
- Learning disabilities
- Developmental delay
- Childhood sexual abuse
- Lack of social support
- Promotion of sexual exploitation by family members or peers

#### Objectives:


