

Proposed Park & Rec Projects for Funding by Regional Transportation Choice Fund (4th Quarter)

Project Location	Funding Amount Requested	Project Description
Cardiff By-Pass Trail (Big Cottonwood Canyon)	\$100,000	Re-alignment/extension of the trail to Donut Falls from the Cardiff Fork Trailhead. Moves trail users off of Cardiff road onto a trail that brings users to the Donut Falls trailhead. A proposed pedestrian bridge and an 8 foot wide boardwalk will cross about 350 feet of wetland to connect to re-aligned portion of the trail to Donut Falls.
Rose Yellow Fork Canyon Recreation Area	\$405,000	Design and construct 1-3 new trailheads both in the Rose Canyon and Butterfield Canyon area. Trail wayfinding renovation and needed redesign.
Bonneville Shoreline Trail – West Side	\$20,000	Determine preliminary alignment for Bonneville Shoreline Trail on the west side of Salt Lake County. Possible alignment will start from the southwest corner of the county in Yellow / Butterfield Canyons, north to Magna and the Tooele County Line.
Jordan River Recreation Area Phase 1 – New Trail on east side of the river	\$245,313	Salt Lake County Parks & Recreation is collaborating with the City of Millcreek to utilize land owned by the County and the City to develop a new section of the Jordan River Trail on the east side of the river from Meadowbrook Expressway (4000 West) to the confluence of the Jordan River and Big Cottonwood Creek (approximately 4200 South). Once completed, the new trail will create a loop system in the area, expanding the overall quality and enhanced experience for the user.
