- Provides case management for 600– 800 clients

  - Treatment Centers

## Drug Court Organizational Chart



#### Metro Gang Unit

- Leads Gang Suppression Unit
- Identifies, documents, and tracks gangs and known gang members
- Provides support for violent gangrelated crimes
- Collaborates with Federal, State, Local partners

## Investigations - MIU/DEA/Cold Case/MHU/ECC

#### MIU

- Violent fugitive apprehension
- Threat assessments
- Federal firearm violations
- Sensitive and unique cases

One Detective is assigned to the Attorney General's Task Force

#### DEA

- Dismantles large-scale drug trafficking organizations
- Cleans up clandestine labs

#### Cold Case

 Investigates unsolved missing persons and homicide cases


#### Mental Health Unit

- Co-response and proactive follow-up by LEO and LCSW
- Reduce violent outcomes and prevent unnecessary incarceration
- More than 5,000 calls annually

#### Jail Investigations

- Criminal investigations at all County facilities
- Jail death investigations in partnership with South Salt Lake PD and District Attorney's Office

# Warrants/ Pawn/ Extraditions

#### Warrants

- Enters warrants on NCIC
- Transmits all criminal information from the District Attorney

#### **Pawns**

Monitors pawn shop compliance

#### **Extraditions (Statutory Duty)**

- Facilitates all extraditions within Salt Lake County
- Returns fugitives to other states


