RE: BHSAC – Council Member Reappointment Request

Dear Michelle -

The Behavioral Health Services Advisory Council (BHSAC) is seeking reappointment for current council member, Evan Done. Evan's first appointed two-year term will expire on November 30, 2020 and he is currently eligible for two additional 2-year terms. A motion was made during the last BHSAC meeting held October 7, 2020 to submit this request to the Mayor and County Council for review and consideration for reappointment. The BHSAC members voted unanimously in support of the motion to request reappointment for Evan Done for a second 2-year term.

Evan Done is the Development Director for Utah Support Advocates for Recovery Awareness (USARA). USARA spearheads Utah's advocacy efforts to educate and provide information about substance use disorders and recovery to local policy makers and the community. Mr. Done's expertise and experience in advocacy work within the recovery community is complimentary to the work and initiatives of this advisory council. In addition, Mr. Done is a person in long-term recovery from both a substance use and mood disorder and serves a vital role on the BHSAC as a consumer of the services this council oversees. His lived experience as a consumer of behavioral health services in Salt Lake County has been an invaluable asset to the advisory council as he brings a unique perspective on the issues and initiatives frequently discussed therein. Evan also identifies as a member of the LGBTQIA+ community and is able to discuss and advocate for and from the perspective of this population as well.
