RE: Request by Black Current, LLC to grant a property tax exemption as an educational organization for the 2019 tax year on parcel 16-17-204-034 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on March 18, 2021, considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as an educational organization for the 2019 tax year on the abovementioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In October 2020 the District Attorney's office recommended the approval of the exemption from July 31, 2019 to December 31, 2019, and the entire 2020 tax year. In October 2020, the Board of Equalization granted a tax exemption for the 2020 tax year and referred the request for the 2019 tax year to the Property Tax Committee for consideration.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for a 42.19% prorated educational exemption for the 2019 tax year. A refund of \$3,286.67 is applicable with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued with the Treasurer's office to determine the final amount to be refunded.
