Dear Robin,

Prior to this letter we have been in communication about The George Q. Morris Foundation donating funds to make over the Salt Lake County Animal Services Agility Dog Run. On January 28, 2021 I began scheduling meetings with local Utah companies to provide bids for artificial turf. To date, four different companies have come out to measure and view the agility dog run. I have also reached out to five additional companies to provide bids for agility equipment. On March 5, 2021 I provided you hard copies of all the bids recently received and separated them by company.

We spoke again on the morning of March 8, 2021 where we discussed moving forward with The George Q. Morris Foundation in donating enough funding to cover the entire dog agility run by installing brand new artificial turf. We both agreed that Rocky Mountain Artificial Turf would be the best company to go through (see attached official bid). Also, during this time you advised that the Foundation would not be donating to cover the cost of agility equipment. Shortly after our telephone conversation I received a text from you stating "Consider this a written confirmation that the Foundation is on board with \$20,570.00 it's second support contribution for 2021."

Once Salt Lake County Animal Services receives said donation from The George Q. Morris Foundation in the amount of \$20,600.00 we will then submit the bids to Contracts & Procurements. Contracts & Procurements have already advised that they will be going with the lowest bid which is the Rocky Mountain Artificial Turf Company. They will then write a check for 50% of the cost of the project (\$10,285.00) to get the job started. Once the artificial turf has been installed, Contracts & Procurements will write Rocky Mountain Artificial Turf another check for the remaining 50% (\$10,285.00). Per your request, when available I will provide you both copies of said checks. One hundred percent of the \$20,570.00 of this donation will go towards paying for the artificial turf



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for our Agility Dog Run and \$30.00 will go to purchasing dog and cat treats for the shelter pets.

We are also in agreement that Salt Lake County Animal Services will raise funding to purchase the agility equipment. We will be promoting this by advertising that "because of the generosity of The George Q. Morris Foundation for donating brand new artificial turf to be installed we are 75% of the way to having our Agility Dog Run complete." This is where we will be asking the community for help. We will also be using our Clickbid software to help advertise by showing a "financial thermostat" of our goal allowing donors to view where we are and how much more we need to raise to get the funding for the agility equipment. We will be promoting this through emails, social media and word of mouth.

Remodeling this agility run means so much to us here at Salt Lake County Animal Services because this space has been unusable and unsafe for many years. We are beyond excited and appreciative of the extreme generosity of The George Q. Morris Foundation for giving this agility dog run new life by providing funding for brand new artificial turf. Once completed many shelter dogs and Salt Lake County Animal Services staff members are guaranteed to be enjoying this space and making the most out of it.

Because of the generosity of The George Q. Morris Foundation, Salt Lake County Animal Services would like to add perks for making this project a reality and being a Sponsor for the Agility Dog Run.

Perks of Sponsoring Salt Lake County Animal Services Agility Dog Run:
