Dear Chair Snelgrove:

At the January 24, 2019 meeting of the Salt Lake County Council of Governments (COG), the following corridor preservation projects were considered and approved as recommended by the COG Public Works Committee at their meeting on January 4, 2019:

Riverton: \$78,000 for 4515 West 12600 South

Unincorporated Salt Lake County: \$1,043,062 for 7300 West (U-111 future alignment to approximately 6665 West) 12600 South

Total Funding Approval: \$1,121,062

Once each municipality has completed the real estate transaction and a Settlement Statement is sent to the County indicating the amount of the requested reimbursement along with other necessary documentation, an Interlocal Agreement will be presented to the County Council seeking approval for the distribution of funds from the Corridor Preservation Fund for specific cities. From there, notice of such approval will be forwarded to the Salt Lake County Mayor Jenny Wilson for disbursement of the funds noted.
