


What Will this Cost an Average Household?

- Average Household in Salt Lake County
 - \$436,000 Home
 - \$89.93 per year at Certified Rate 0.000375
 - \$95.92 per year at Authorized Rate 0.0004

• \$5.99 (7%) per year difference to maintain the rate at 0.0004



Why the District Should Maintain the .0004 Rate?

- District Construction Projects
 - Mitigates unpredictable Federal contributions
- Capital Improvement / Replacement
 - Supports long-term planning models set by past and present CUWCD Board of Trustees
- Debt Management
 - Less need to go to bond market
 - Maintain ratings which minimizes the cost of debt
 - Meets long-term financial obligations (50-year block notice repayment schedules)

 - Treatment Plants
 - Federal Facilities
 - North Fork Siphon Replacement
 - Alpine Aqueduct Replacement

 - Spanish Fork-Santaquin Pipeline
- Large-Scale Water Right Purchases
- Conservation Projects
- Planning and Studies
- Unplanned/Emergency Response Projects
