OUR MISSION


We help County agencies improve public services by utilizing and sharing data internally and externally, empowering employees to make data-driven decisions, and promoting a culture of continuous improvement.

 - Developed Path-Forward 2.0
- 2018
 - Performance Management System contract discontinued.
 - Developed CountyStat
 - Administrative Services pilot launched.


Performance

Salt Lake County's Performance Management System

- Decentralized (agency level) Performance Management System.
- Outcomes are prioritized by the agency and department leadership.
- Reviewed during the budget meetings.
- Office of Data & Innovation provides **training**, **tools and support** to collect data and report O/I performance dashboards on CountyStat.
- Not all agencies are using CountyStat to report their Outcomes & Indicator progress.
- No policy framework exist to require agencies to report performance data.
