




COVID-19 Cases Are 1% Higher Than In 2020




Cases Are Decreasing Across Age Groups

Percentage of Cases by School Type




First Test-To-Stay Event At American Prep Academy

291 (23.8%) Opted Out and Stayed Home for 10 Days




Hospitalizations Are On The Rise For Most Ages





Salt Lake County ICUs Are At Capacity Today






COVID-19 Deaths On The Rise Since Delta






