Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on October 21, 2021, considered acceptance into the tax deferral program under Utah Code 59-2-1347. The property was pulled from the 2021 final tax sale for review under Hardship Deferral under the authority granted to the Committee.

The Committee regrettably recommends denial of hardship relief and a deferral at this time. The property will be certified for the May 2022 tax sale if the outstanding balance is not paid by March 15, 2022. This decision does not preclude the applicant from requesting consideration of a deferral at a later date. In order for hardship relief and a deferral to be reconsidered, the applicant must contact the Abatement Office, pay any amounts necessary, and submit all required documentation.

An administrative fee of no less than \$250.00 will be added to any property that is certified for sale. The final 2022 tax sale is tentatively scheduled for May 26, 2022.

Please notify the Salt Lake County Treasurer, Salt Lake County Auditor, and the applicant of your decision.
