Mr. Gary Edwards, Director, Salt Lake County Health Department, updated the Council on the status of the Hepatitis A outbreak, and efforts by the Health Department to address the problem and prevent future outbreaks.

Ms. Michelle Vowles, Lead Epidemiologist, delivered a PowerPoint presentation reviewing the Hepatitis A outbreak, its causes, symptoms, and protection, outbreaks in other states, and public health response.

2.3 Funding of Unified Police Department Officers Assigned to the <u>18-248</u> DEA Taskforce via the Interlocal Agreement with Unified Police Department

Presenters: Council Members Jim Bradley and Jenny Wilson (Approx 15 min.)

Council Member DeBry stated Herriman City has left the Unified Police Department (UPD), and the loss of that revenue has an affect on the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Metro Narcotics Task Force. He is asking the County to contribute funds, if it becomes necessary, to keep two detectives on the task force.

Captain Carroll Mays, DEA Metro Task Force, explained the work of the task force in dealing with the opioid crisis.

Council Member Wilson stated if these detectives are lost, the cost to retrain and get them back in the team is really high, double or more. She is comfortable with the County appropriating an "up to" amount to the task force. The cost for these positions is \$274,000; \$137,000 per officer.

A motion was made by Council Member Wilson, seconded by Council Member Bradley, that the Council appropriate up to \$274,000 from the appropriate General Fund to the Sheriff's budget to be authorized for DEA Metro Narcotics Task Force purposes, in the event those funds are necessary.
