**Council Member Jensen** stated the Council discussed this item during its Committee of the Whole meeting held on July 17, 2018, at which time the Council decided not to offer this voluntary benefit. Since that time, he received additional information and now feels comfortable offering this benefit.

**Mr. Tom McCormick**, Chief Growth Officer, BMG Money, stated BMG offers loans to employees of municipalities at a simple rate of 23.9 percent. This is a good deal when compared to Pay Day loans at 450 percent. There is no cost or risk to the County.

Council Member DeBry stated government should not be in the business of loaning money.

**Council Member Bradshaw** asked if the County put out an RFP for this benefit.

**Ms. Erin Litvack**, Deputy Mayor of County Services, stated yes. The RFP is open and the Human Resources Division can move forward with this, if approved.

Council Member Wilson asked if the contract had an exit option.

**Mr. McCormick** stated he would go on record to say that if the County wanted to terminate its contract, BMG would only need a 30-day notice.

**Council Member Bradshaw** stated County employees could borrow against their 401(k)s at a lower rate of prime plus 1 percent.

**Ms.** Nilsa Carter, Director, Human Resources Division, stated that was correct, but not all County employees had a 401(k).

**Council Member Snelgrove** stated he was concerned the County would be perceived as encouraging employees to get deeper in debt. Also, 26 percent is high interest and he did not want to encourage that.
